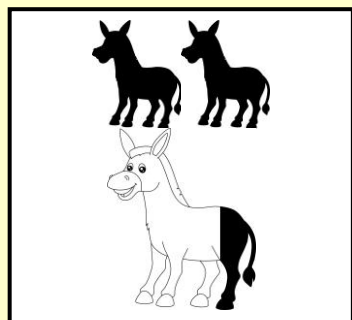
MISSION PROJECT
