The Grace Space is open for anyone who needs the option of being in a different space during the worship service. Parents are welcome to be in this space with their children to watch the service in an environment where they will not disrupt others. Children respond well to expectations set ahead of time as well as a regular routine. Whether you choose to use the room for the entire service, only during the message, or just on days when you need another option; this room is available for anyone who needs it. We want the Grace Space to be a comfortable and safe place where you and your child can still engage in our morning service. The Grace Space is located in the back of the worship center.

Faith Formation begins Sunday, September 13! At Bethel, we want all generations together on Sunday mornings. This begins in the worship service and continues with fellowship afterwards where all members of The Family (all members of the church), from oldest to youngest, have opportunities to connect with one another. Discussion Guides will be available beginning September 13 with activities that are built around that morning's message. No advance preparation is needed, nor does anyone need to be an expert or the teacher. Everyone is simply invited to participate in the FAITH 5 activities: SHARE, READ, TALK, PRAY, and BLESS. Faith Formation is not so much about what we know, it has much more to do with how we live. Understanding and knowing how to live comes from watching, experiencing and sharing how faith is lived out by others. This is what we seek to do as the Bethel Family. We want to be a place **Where The Family Grows Together.**

Wednesday Night Kids begins September 16! We are excited to continue with the New Testament of *The Jesus Storybook Bible*. Registration is open at BethelSheldon.org for children who are 4 years old by 9/15/2026 through those entering 6th Grade. Wednesday Night Kids is an exciting collaborative ministry of Bethel and Living Water Community Church. We meet from 6:15 - 7:30 p.m. and children are grouped by age and led by two caring leaders. Our time is spent in small groups reading and responding to the Bible story as well as in a large group praising God and highlighting the main point of our lesson through a fun activity. Preschool Playgroup will begin on Thursday, September 10 from 9:30 - 10:30 am. Parents and grandparents are invited to come with their preschooler to introduce them to structured time with peers and have some free play time. Adults are encouraged to participate as an example for the children, but the structure is loose enough that adults are able to converse with each other while interacting with the children. Our time together includes a Bible story, activities to reinforce that story (puzzle, game, craft or song), a snack and free play.
